Normal Operation	Adult supervision at all times Rule and expectations of behaviour thoroughly explained before the beginning Supervisor sets starting boundaries to control speed Challenge by choice Ratios not exceeded Check medical conditions prior to activity	Supervisor to check waterslide for damage before and after use Supervisor ensures that the flow of water coming down the slide is not too heavy Supervisor to ensure participants are wearing appropriate clothing If pegs are used, ensure are firm into the ground	Supervisor checks the surface of the slide before each group begins the rotation Supervisor sweeps surface of slide between participants
